Tauranga City Basketball Representative Team Head Coach

Reports to: Director of Development.

All Age-groups

General attributes required

- Be committed and enthusiastic to be involved in TCBA programmes
- Act as a positive ambassador and spokesperson for TCBA and TCBA Programmes
- Not work in competition with TCBA Programmes
- Have good communication skills
- Have good team building skills
- Be willing to work as a member of a team, within the TCBA coaching community
- Be willing to share information and experiences to other members of the basketball coaching community.
- Seek and involve self in development opportunities

Basketball attributes required:

- Technical and tactical knowledge required for the level of position applied for.
- Either coaching or playing experience at a similar or higher level of than the position applied for.
- Knowledge of the required skill and training levels for elite athletes relevant to the position applied for.
- Ability to design a season plan / master plan, which will form a base to plan practise sessions from.

Tauranga City Basketball general requirements:

- Understand that the representative programme has a no recruitment policy. Representative Coaches must not attempt to recruit representative players to any school, club or training programme they are involved in.
- Run trials in accordance with Tauranga City Basketball Representative Trial procedures.
- Be able to attend two training per week (generally one mid-week and one on Sunday).
- Coach the team at ALL events entered by Tauranga City Basketball – please see [draft](#) calendar attached.
- Not book or agree to any training sessions for rep teams unless agreed to by the Director of Development.
- Be a willing and proactive supporter of all TCBA Programmes.
- Understand the bigger picture of player development and that this is a long-term process.
- Attend coaching meetings as required.
- Two weeks after the conclusion of the team's games for the season submit a written report of the season.
- Be aware of and be able to follow Basketball New Zealand's Coaches Code of Conduct
- Wear TCBA apparel at all TCBA Rep programme and development programme sessions.

Under 17, 15, 13 & 11

Requirements:

- Be willing to undertake learning in the role of a mentee
- Be willing to mentor assistant coaches
- Coach and participate actively in the TCBA Development Programme – Navigators (to be on-court and active during sessions).

U11, 13, 15 & 17 age-groups will all attend the Navigators Programme as a requirement of taking part in the Representative Programme.

Under 19 & Under 23

Requirements:

- Create player booklets including KPI, team philosophies, offensive and defensive plays.

Please note: TCBA will provide support and training for areas where coaches require assistance. TCBA reserves the right to remove coaches who fail to meet the above requirements.
